24th Sept: Meet the Teacher @ 3.15pm; 4.15pm & 5pm

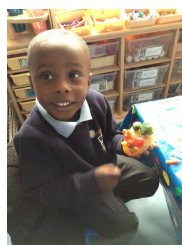
25th Sept: Welcome Mass @ 10am in the school hall
